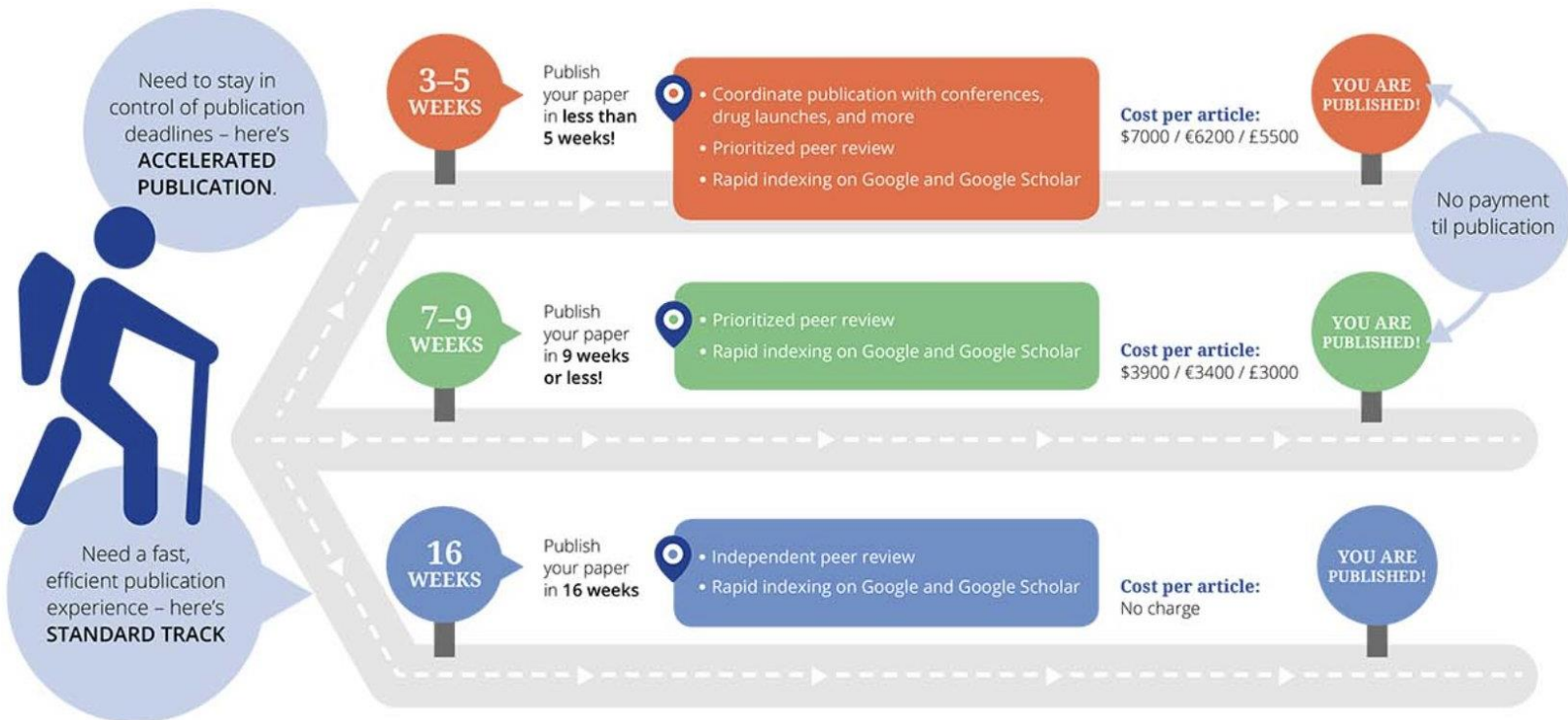

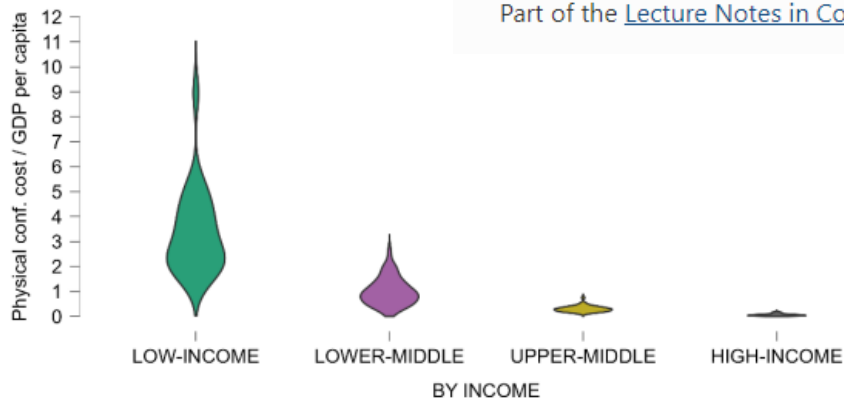


Fig. 2. The ratio of iConference2023 participation cost for physical event to GDP by country income groups.

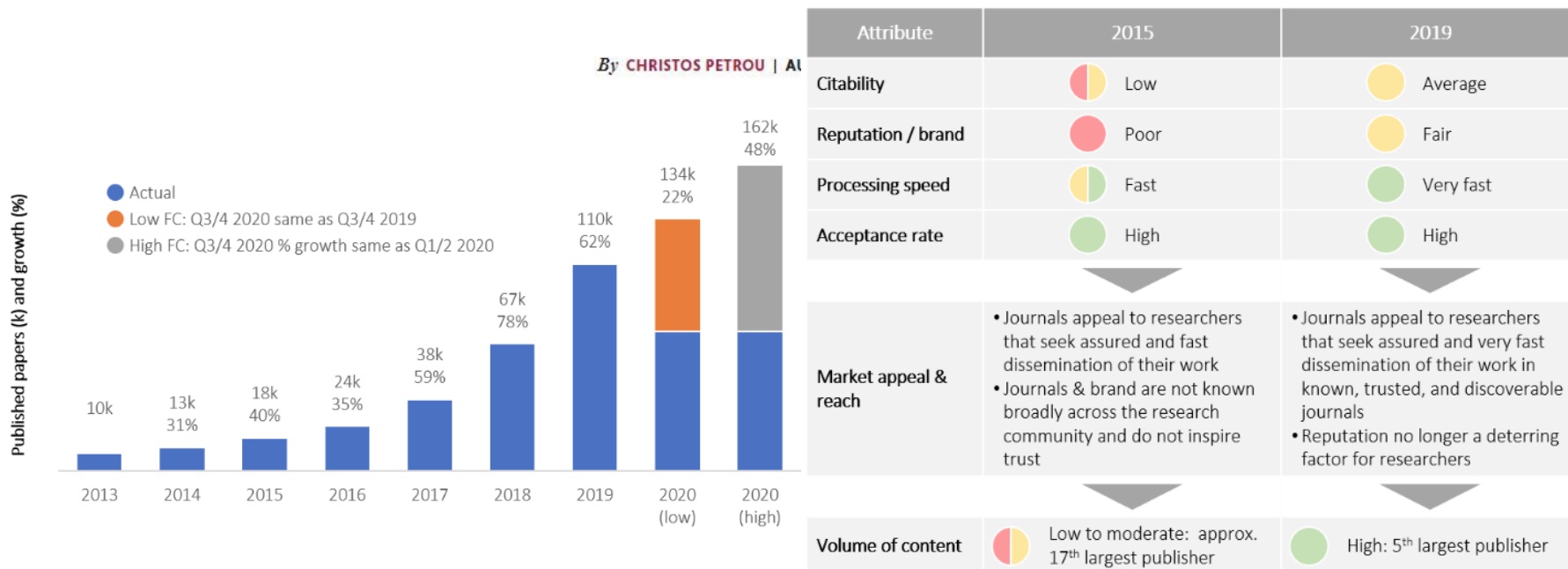

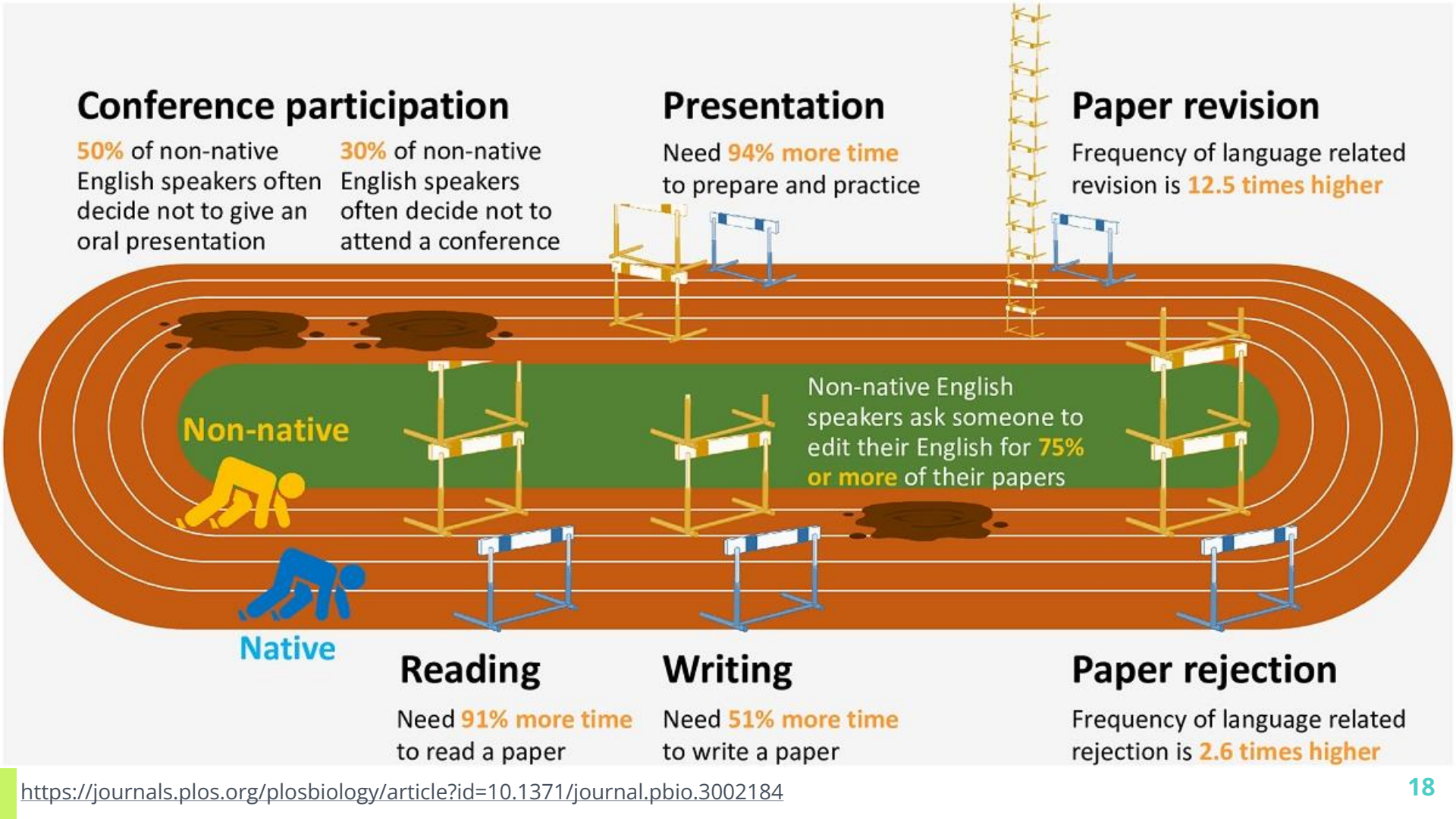

In the three years since its announcement, [Plan S](#), an initiative dedicated to making scientific research publicly available, has attracted new members, including international organizations and government funding agencies from around the world. A number of researchers question the global impact of Plan S's implementation, however, raising concerns that its stringent open-access mandates have contributed to an increase in associated publishing costs that could potentially cut into research budgets and exacerbate inequalities that already exist in science publishing.

Plan S is a set of requirements drafted in September 2018 by a newly formed group of 11 national funding agencies across Europe collectively dubbed cOAlition S and supported by the European Commission and, initially, the European Research Council. The group aims to end the reign of paywalls and promote a transition to a fully open-access publishing model in science.

Traditionally, scientific journals have been sustained by subscriptions paid by libraries, institutions, and individual readers, while authors have published mostly for free. The number of journals and their subscription fees have grown in recent decades. For instance, one [analysis](#) reported 515- and 479-percent increases in the average price of library subscriptions to physical science and medical journals, respectively, between 1984 and 2001. The fast rise in subscription prices has been one of the motivations behind the push for open-access publishing, in which authors pay a fee known as an article processing charge (APC) to publish, but content is freely available.

Open-access publishing fees deter researchers in the global south

Authors in low-income countries rarely published free-to-read papers, even when they qualified for publication-fee waivers.

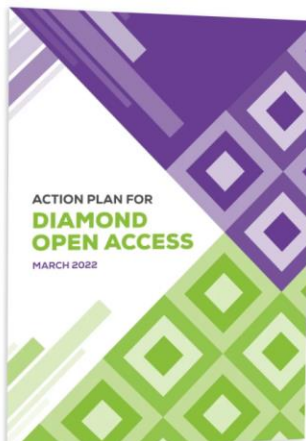

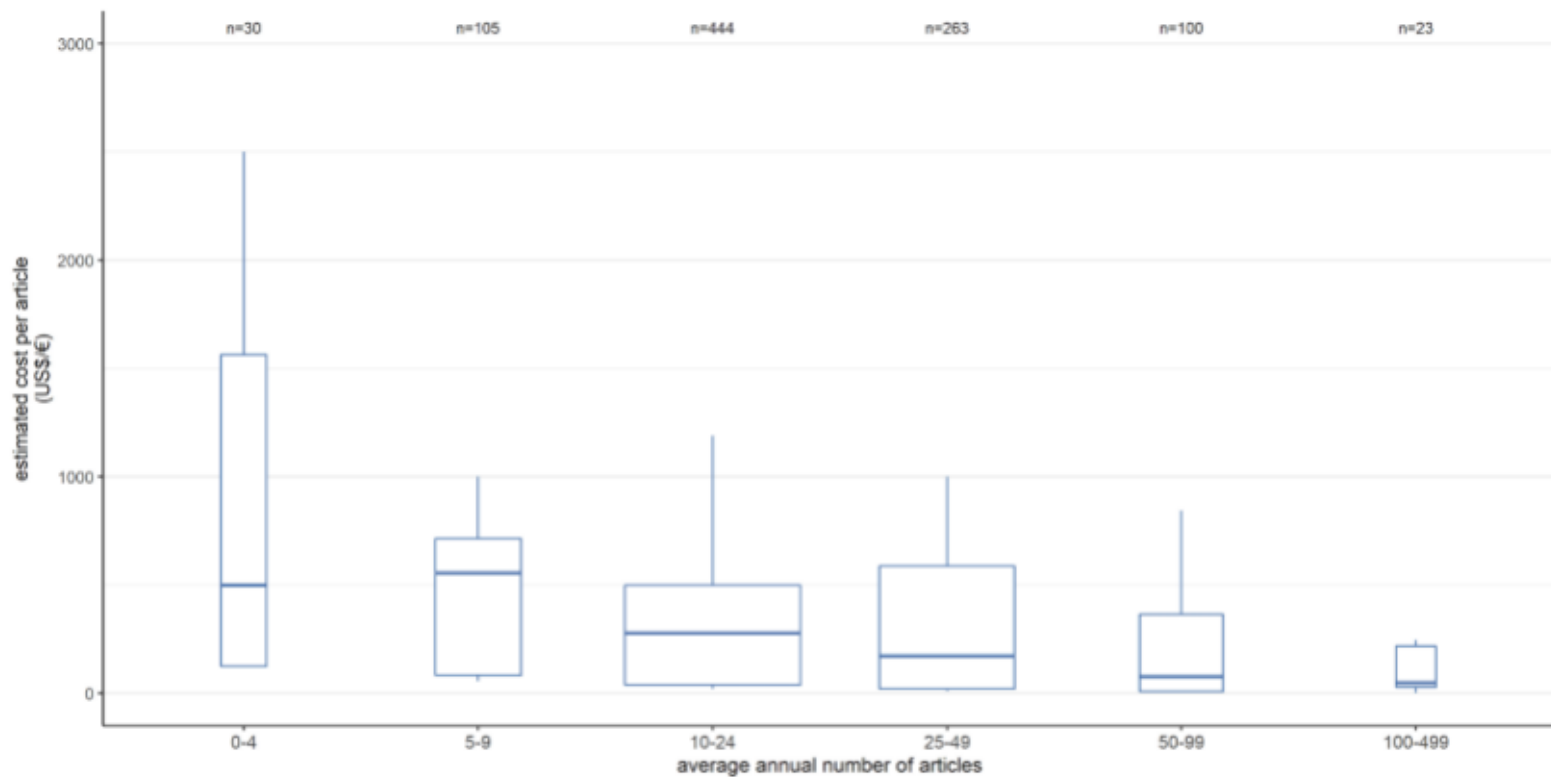


Figure 5. Distribution of estimated cost per article for diamond OA journals by journal size

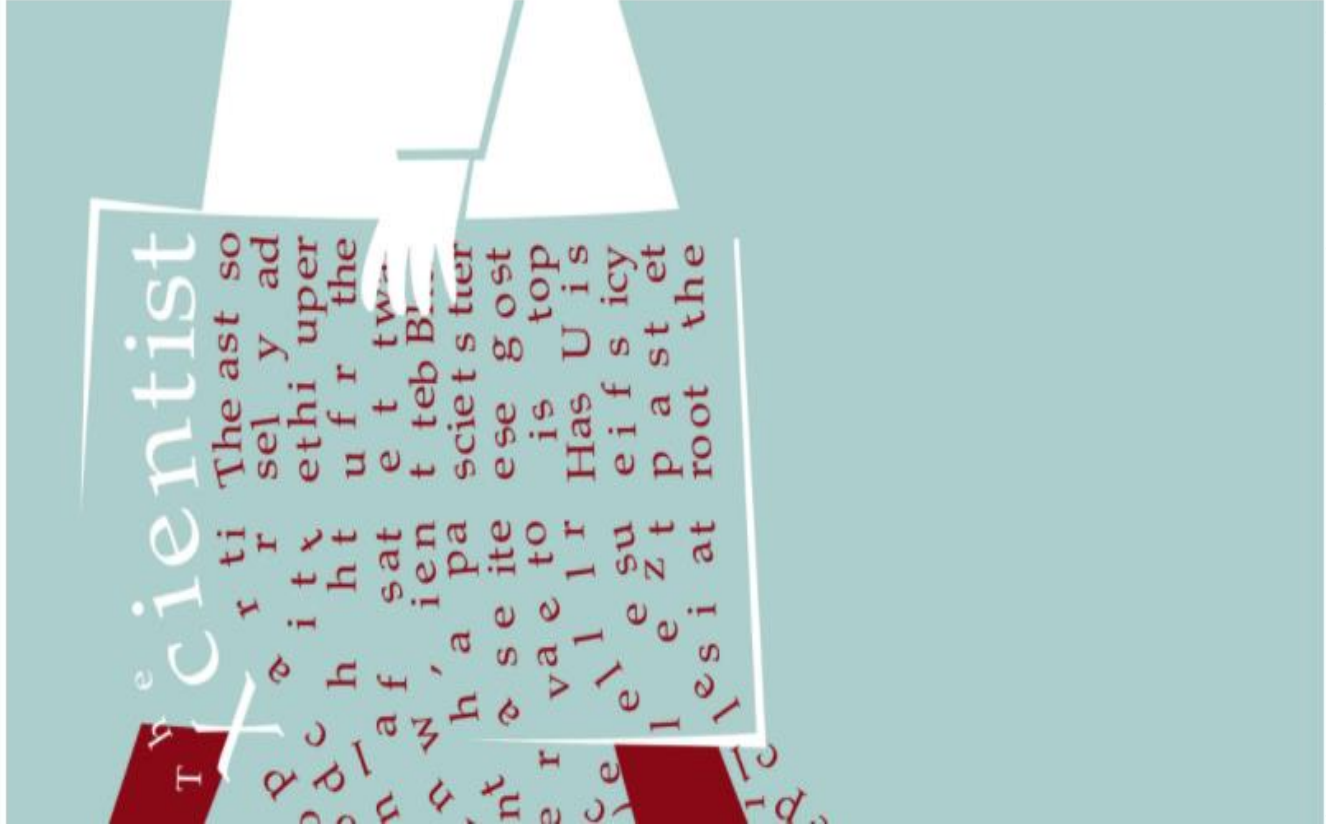

The pressure on university scientists to publish research papers in great quantity is relentless; and the motive behind it is clear. More papers mean more prestige for a researcher's department—and the prestige will translate, department heads hope, into more financial support from the university. Unfortunately, this pressure is likely to prompt disreputable, unethical, and even fraudulent publication practices. At the very least, the pressure encourages scientists to adjust their priorities, putting more important work off in order to prepare for publication material that otherwise would not be submitted.

Of course, there are those who sincerely hold that quantity of scientific publication can be equated with quality of scientific achievement. But there is a fallacy in this logic: An increase in the number of publications per author actually can be attributed not so much to greater productivity, but to changes in the way researchers publish.

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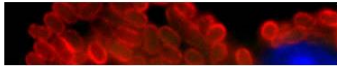

The main characteristics of the efficiency of the use of mass and serial production technical products, are their performance and cost, as determined in the specific conditions. 1. Alternative Impact Factor

Several journal metrics are calculated. The first metric is an alternative Google Scholar's citation count.

The journal impact factor (JIF) normally referred to is the Thomson Reuters calculated based on the Web of Science (WoS) Reports® (JCR). We call this the **JCR®JIF**. DOAJ writes: recognised impact factor that is generated by Thomson Reuters, a profit making organisation. It runs against the ethics and principles of JCR®JIF, but an alternative Google-based impact factor.

Today 57 % of readers find their way to SCIRP's articles via Google Scholar. No open or proprietary database is directing so many readers to SCIRP's articles. Google Scholar is the only openly available database suitable for journal metric calculation. It has a wide coverage and is a meaningful source. For this reason, SCIRP is calculating its own Impact Factor based on **Google Scholar's citation counts**. Scientists are used to Thomson Reuters' way of calculating an impact factor. For this reason, SCIRP applies **Thomson Reuters'(TR) algorithm** as published on <http://wokinfo.com/essays/impact-factor> in Figure 1. This algorithm is not protected and can be used by anyone. In short: SCIRP calculates a **2-year Google-based Journal Impact Factor (2-GJIF)**.

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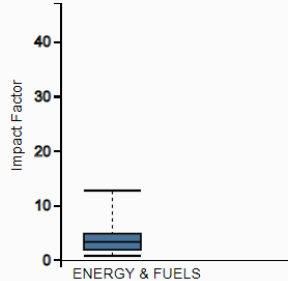
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Category Box Plot

The horizontal line that forms the bottom is the 25th percentile (Q_3). The horizontal line that intersects the box is the median Impact Factor for the category.

Horizontal lines above and below the box, called *whiskers*, represent maximum and minimum values. The top whisker is the smaller of the following two values:
the maximum Impact Factor (IF)

The bottom whisker is the larger of the following two values:
the minimum Impact Factor (IF)

Abstract:

Methodological issues of development psychology of education including search of its premised bases from the area of philosophy and psychology, the analysis of logical aspects and critical analyses is discussed in the article. The specific of philosophy of education is expressed: it implies the process of reflective thinking towards the theory and practice; the educational process and the perspectives of its development taken as a whole; the verification of rational educational strategies. The discussed problem is focused on the category of **comprehension in psycho-pedagogical research** combining gnoseological, reflexive and empathy aspects. Semantic content of pedagogical knowledge presupposes the specific activity of a recipient and a researcher-methodologist which includes: identification of premise philosophical and psychological foundations of this knowledge, reflexion on author's logical reasoning of the knowledge being researched and presented in whether any other text, in-depth critical comprehension of the content of research products and their conclusions; gradual attainment of the stage of comprehension of pedagogical knowledge fragment, perceiving it in the logic of **catching** the integrity, consistency and unity of different facts, objects, processes and phenomena; revealing and further implementation of such element as knowledge about unknown positions. The current development of psychology and philosophy gives every reason to believe the problem to be one of the white spots in methodology of pedagogy and psychology, to position it as a productive research field for beginners.
